Key topics will include: access point creation (plus associated roadworks) scheduled for March & April 2025. These works are to provide access to the landfall site where installation activity will begin in September 2025. We will hold another event in the summer to share more information about installation works at the landfall site.

RWE have begun onshore construction of Norfolk Offshore Wind Zone. Once fully operational, the Norfolk Zone could generate 4.2GW of electricity, which is enough to power more than 4 million UK households.
